



Membership at Horton Park Golf Club

Thank you for your interest in membership at Horton Park Golf Club.

In this pack you will find information about the club and on the many benefits of membership along with details of how to join and the membership fees.

At Horton Park Golf Club we have an 18-hole parkland course, the **Millennium** course, which is set within the grounds of Horton Country Park and plays 6010 yards long from the white tees. Our signature hole is the par 3 10th which is the longest island green par 3 hole in England! Wildlife is in abundance out on the course especially around our water holes, and you may even spot a deer if you're lucky. The course has benefited from large investment over the past few years and is now in the best condition it has ever been in, both summer and winter.

To compliment the millennium course we have a 9-hole Par 3 **Academy** course and a covered 26 bay floodlit driving range which features Top Tracer screen technology in every bay and uses the highest quality Srixon range balls. Booking is made in time slots online. We also have a short game area with bunkers and a putting green, perfect to practice your short game. If you are looking to relax and have a bit of fun with friends or family then we also have an 18-hole Jungle Island Adventure Golf Course.

Finally, when you have worked up an appetite you can enjoy some great food and drink served throughout the day in our recently extended and refurbished clubhouse and orangery, featuring an extensive food and drinks menu, Italian coffee and Sky & BT Sports. Ordering is primarily via an App.

We have three principal types of membership to choose from at Horton Park Golf Club depending on how often you like to play; 5 Day membership (Mon-Fri), 7 Day membership (seven days a week) or Flexi membership which means you only pay for the golf you play using credits.

Choosing the Right Membership

Becoming a member at Horton Park Golf Club is quick and easy. All you need to do is choose which membership will suit your lifestyle and playing habits, complete an application form and choose how you wish to pay.

There are two payment options available to choose from when you join and include the following terms and conditions:

Option One: Annual Membership

If you choose to pay in one lump sum at the start of your membership year you will now be committing to the full year and you will be unable to cancel your membership part way through the year under any circumstances and no refunds will be given including any unused Flexi credits.

Option Two: Monthly Membership

If you choose to pay monthly by direct debit you will have the right to cancel your membership at the end of any month.



Horton 7 Day Membership - £1050 or £96 monthly

Valid 7 days a week at Horton Park Golf Club only

Access to both of our golf courses, Footgolf courses, and Adventure Golf 7 days per week

A joining fee of £199 applies for this membership category.



Horton 5 Day Membership - £750 or £66 monthly

Valid 5 days a week at Horton Park Golf Club only

Access to both of our golf courses, Footgolf courses, and Adventure Golf 5 days per week

Excludes play at the weekend and bank holidays.

A joining fee of £199 applies for this membership category.



Horton Intermediate (Age 25-29) - £575 or £51 monthly

Access to both of our golf courses, Footgolf courses, and Adventure Golf 7 days per week

A joining fee of £99 applies for this membership category.



Flexi Membership – from £395

Valid 7 days a week on any of the courses at Horton Park Golf Club

Flexible Membership offers a whole new approach to being a member of our club. It is straight-forward and as the name suggests, completely flexible. As a member you will pay for only the golf you play using credits.



How it works

When you join you pay an annual fee of £220 and purchase a minimum bundle of 100 credits for £175, however you can buy larger bundles as the more credits you buy, the better value you receive. When you book a tee time you will use your credits as set out below.

Please note that there is not an option to pay monthly by direct debit with this membership.

If you run out of credits you can top up with any of the credit bundles below and any remaining credits can be carried over to the following year subject to payment of the annual fee and buying a minimum bundle of 50 credits.

Under 25 Membership



Young Adult (Age 18-24) - £420 or £42 monthly

We feel it is important to encourage young golfers to be able continue to play sport whilst they may have other financial commitments such as further education fees. Valid 7 days a week on any of the courses in the Maple Leaf Golf Group including Adventure Golf and Footgolf at Horton Park and Chichester Golf clubs.

There is a £99 joining fee for this membership category.



Junior Membership (Age 15-17) - £180

Valid 7 days a week on any of the courses in the Maple Leaf Golf Group including Adventure Golf and Footgolf at Horton Park and Chichester Golf Clubs

There is no joining fee for this membership category.



Junior Membership (Age under 15) - £145

Valid 7 days a week on any of the courses in the Maple Leaf Golf Group Adventure Golf and Footgolf at Horton Park and Chichester Golf Clubs

There is no joining fee for this membership category.



Benefits of Membership

Member Playing Rights

As per your chosen category, all members are entitled to play on both courses at Horton Park Golf Club with no green fee required to be paid. Pre-booking is essential.

Booking a tee time

Members can book a tee time up to 14 days in advance, 2 days ahead of general visitors and ideally are made online using the Elite Live App, otherwise in person at the club or over the telephone. This applies to both the Millennium and Academy golf courses.

Members Guests

Members can invite guests to play and pay a reduced green fee rate. Not applicable to Junior Members.

Competitions & Weekly Roll Ups

We have very active members sections within the Club who organise regular competitions and social events. All events are mixed (men's and ladies) which is a unique feature of Horton Park's competition set up. Most competitions are held on Wednesdays and Sundays, with more informal events held on Saturdays.

The ladies run specific competitions on Thursdays at 9am

If you are aged 50 years and over you might like to consider joining the HOGGS Section. They have a competition every Monday.

Juniors

We have one of the most active junior set ups in the country involving many coaching classes and competitions. In order to get your child into the most relevant session please ask for the junior organisers contact information in the Golf Shop. Our shop is called "**The Kids Golf Store**" and we hold the largest amount of kids golf product anywhere in the area. Junior members can receive a **10% discount** on all product if they use their Levy account via their membership swipe card.

Getting a Handicap

If you do not have a current handicap and you would like one, you will need to submit three score cards signed by another member who has a handicap. If you would like us to arrange for some playing partners to sign these cards for you please just enquire in the golf shop and we will put you in touch with some fellow members.

We can also arrange for junior members to achieve a handicap. You don't have to be able to get a specific score to gain a handicap as we operate a Club handicap system which goes up to 54. All you need to do to get this is complete three scorecards; it is really easy!

Exclusive discounts for Members

- All annual & monthly membership fees include affiliation fees paid to England Golf and the Surrey County Golf Union (men) or Surrey Ladies County Golf Association (ladies). Personal Liability Insurance cover up to £10,000,000 is provided by Bluefin Sport as an additional benefit of the affiliation fees paid to England Golf.



- Members can obtain a 10% discount on retail items from the shop and food and drink purchases in the Clubhouse (exclusions apply). To take advantage of the discount you need to add a 'levy' to your account, of which the minimum top up amount is £10.
- Members receive a discounted buggy hire rate and should be pre-booked along with the tee time. Buggies are available all year round regardless of the weather due to our newly installed buggy paths. Upon booking, members will be advised on the buggy regulations for the day with regards to buggy path use.

Driving Range

Members can book a time slot in a bay via our Resova Range Booking System which can be found on our website www.hortonparkgolf.com

Jungle Island Adventure Golf

All Members can play Adventure Golf for free or 3 credits for flexi members. (Days subject to chosen category).

Escape Rooms

Members receive a 10% discount across all of our Escape Rooms and must be booked in advance.

Changing Rooms

Our member shower and locker rooms are accessible via a pin code with coin operated lockers available. (Currently unavailable due to Covid restrictions)
